UPDATE/FACTS**

Runnymede Healthcare Centre is committed to listening to its community. Based on your feedback, we have made the following modifications to the plan for our proposed long-term care (LTC) home:

Feedback	Update
<p>Building height:</p> <p>The community has indicated that the proposed six-storey height of the building is a concern.</p>	<p>Runnymede has radically reshaped the design of the entire building. By increasing accommodation for residents, the massing of the building has become more compact and allowed us to eliminate the top floor of the building.</p> <p>The newly designed LTC home will be five storeys. Its proposed height will be now be only slightly higher than the existing hospital.</p>
<p>Traffic:</p> <p>Residents expressed concern for the potential of increased traffic on St. Johns Road.</p>	<p>The potential for an increase of traffic on St. Johns Road has been alleviated by eliminating the proposed exit ramp from the LTC's underground parking garage onto St. Johns. All car traffic will now enter and exit from the existing Runnymede Road entry way.</p>
<p>Open green area access:</p> <p>The community would like to ensure green space is available in the proposed development.</p>	<p>Runnymede is committed to providing its neighbours with as much green space access as possible. By shifting the proposed building further north and shrinking some of the garden area on our property, we have enlarged the available green space.</p>
<p>Project status:</p> <p>The community would like updates on the current project status.</p>	<p>The rezoning process has been delayed due to the resubmission of redesigned plans for the LTC building.</p>
