

NON-DISCLOSURE

In the event that Runnymede decides, in accordance with FIPPA, not to disclose a record, or part of a record that you have requested, you will be provided with a description of the record, the reason(s) for which the record is not being released, and you will be advised of your right to appeal Runnymede's decision to deny access to the Information and Privacy Commissioner/Ontario. The Commissioner has the authority to review all decisions made under FIPPA.



Access to information

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT (FIPPA)

On January 1, 2012 Runnymede Healthcare Centre became subject to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA/the Act).

The Act provides the public with a right of access to general records held by Runnymede and also sets out the hospital's obligations with respect to the protection of personal information.

The Act applies only to records that came into the custody or control of Runnymede on or after January 1, 2007.

PRINCIPLES OF FIPPA

- Information should be available to the public
- Exemptions from the right of access should be limited and specific
- Decisions on whether to provide access may be appealed to the Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario
- Any person may make a request for records held by an institution subject to FIPPA
- To protect individuals from unauthorized collection, use or disclosure of personal information and to provide individuals with a right of access to their own personal information

HOW TO MAKE AN INFORMATION REQUEST UNDER FIPPA

Runnymede is committed to conducting its business in a manner that promotes transparency and accountability. The hospital's operational records are publicly available whenever possible.

To make an information request use the hospital's Access to Personal Information and Correction of Personal Information Request form. This form can be used to:

- Make a request for access to general records of the hospital
- Request personal information
- Request a correction to your personal information

The form is available on www.runnymedehc.ca or at the hospital reception.

You must clearly describe the records you are requesting. To help identify the records, you may wish to consult Runnymede's directory of records which is available on our website or by request to the Information and Privacy Office.

Please note that there are many records that are already published such as Strategic Plans, expense reports and other key Runnymede documents. These can also be viewed on-site in our designated reading room and do not require a formal request.

There is a small administrative charge to place a request for information. Therefore please include a cheque or money order in the amount of \$5 payable to Runnymede Healthcare Centre. Please do not mail cash.

You will receive a response within 30 days.

In addition to the \$5 application fee, FIPPA allows organizations to recover costs for record search and photocopying. You will be notified if your request will cost more than \$25 to process, and you may be asked to pay a deposit if the estimated processing costs exceed \$100.

REQUEST FOR PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

Personal Health Information that is in the custody or control of Runnymede is not subject to FIPPA. It is subject to the Personal Health Information Privacy Act (PHIPA).
