



## **Runnymede Healthcare Centre Long-Term Care UPDATE**

**June 30, 2021**

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Construction of our new Long-Term Care Facility continues with plenty of activity, and we again thank you for your continued patience, and cooperation.

The wood lagging for the shoring system continues in parallel with the mass excavation on the east and south boundaries of the site. The site services work continues to progress with the excavation. Dewatering activities have also commenced with the installation of the wells.

Construction of the tunnel link continues, with waterproofing installed, and the forming underway, and proceeding on schedule to allow for the reinstallation of the main entranceway off of Runnymede as scheduled.

Daily cleanup and inspections will continue, as well as water trucks assisting with dust mitigation. Regular watering with garden hoses has also increased in frequency to assist. Please note you should continue to expect to experience some noise and vibrations on an ongoing basis for the next few months.

In response to the province's updated regulations for such projects, in an effort to expedite the work, to mitigate lost time due to weather, and due to the importance and the critical nature of the long-term care facility, the contractor is anticipating working on Saturdays, as well as some occasional extended hours.

Please be assured that all health and safety protocols will remain in place at all times of work operations, and that vibration monitoring remains installed, and is being monitored for any potential structural impacts.

We do not anticipate disruption to patient activity or care, and we continue to work closely with our clinical teams to ensure that any disruption remains at a minimum.
