

Runnymede Healthcare Centre Long-Term Care

UPDATE

October 6, 2022

Construction of the new Runnymede Long-Term Care Facility continues with plenty of activity, and as always, we again thank you as always for your continued patience, and cooperation.

The installation of the temporary shoring is complete, and bulk excavation is also finished.

Below grade parking structure continues to be installed with foundation work nearly completed, and center portion now approaching street level. The west elevation has progressed with columns and walls above the L1 level. Mechanical and Electrical services also are progressing in accordance with the structure.

Significantly large concrete pours will continue over the next several months which will result in extended work hours to ensure the concrete is placed and finished properly.

Update of utility works executed by the City of Toronto to support the Runnymede LTC project across Fisken and Runnymede now have been completed.

The project has experienced some delays unfortunately and the team is currently investigating mitigation strategies.

Temporary sidewalk and lane closures will also continue on the north side of St. Johns to safely facilitate large deliveries and installations.

Please note you should continue to expect to experience some noise and vibrations on an ongoing basis due to the plan construction activities. All by laws have been shared with the Construction team.

As always, all health and safety protocols will be the utmost importance to the project team and will be followed at all times. As the structure continues above street level, new intense safety measures become implemented.

We do not anticipate disruption to patient activity or care, and we continue to work closely with our clinical teams to ensure that any disruption remains at a minimum.
