Application and admission to long-term care in Ontario, including at Runnymede Long-Term Care Home, is coordinated through **Ontario Health atHome**. A care coordinator will work with you to determine whether you are eligible for admission to a long-term care home and identify homes appropriate for you.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for admission to a long-term care home, individuals must meet the following criteria set out by Ontario's Fixing Long-Term Care Act, 2021:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have a valid Ontario Health Card
- Require:
 - Nursing care to be available on site 24 hours a day
 - Assistance with activities of daily living at frequent intervals throughout the day, or
 - On-site supervision or on-site monitoring to ensure their safety or well-being
- Have health care needs that:
 - Cannot be met with caregiving support at home or community, and
 - **Can** be met in a long-term care home

Accommodation Types and Costs:

- Private rooms with ensuite washroom
- Basic rooms with shared washroom
- Couple rooms may be available depending on the layout of the specific floor

- Modern and Comfortable Living Spaces:
 Designed with seniors' needs in mind, offering additional areas of comfort where residents can enjoy many daily activities.
