In the event that Runnymede decides, in accordance with FIPPA, not to disclose a record, or part of a record, that you have requested, you will be provided with a description of the record and the reason(s) for which the record is not being released. In addition, you will be advised of your right to appeal Runnymede's decision to the Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario. The Commissioner has the authority to review all decisions made under FIPPA.

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WHAT IS FIPPA?

FIPPA stands for the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (referred to as the “Act”). Hospitals are designated as “institutions” under section 2 of FIPPA. Under the Act, an individual has the right to make a request for access to general records in the custody or control of the hospital.

PRINCIPLES OF FIPPA

- Information should be available to the public
- Exemptions from the right of access should be limited and specific
- Decisions on whether to provide access may be appealed to the Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario
- Any person may make a request for records held by an institution subject to FIPPA
- To protect individuals from unauthorized collection, use or disclosure of personal information and to provide individuals with a right of access to their own personal information

HOW TO MAKE AN INFORMATION REQUEST UNDER FIPPA

Runnymede is committed to conducting its business in a manner that promotes transparency and accountability. The hospital's operational records are publicly available whenever possible.

To make an information request, use the hospital's forms, and select:

- Access to Personal Information, and Correction of Personal Information, and select the “Access to General Records” option

The form is available on www.runnymedehc.ca

You must clearly describe the records you are requesting. To help identify the records, you may wish to consult Runnymede's directory of records, which is available on our website or by request to the Information and Privacy Office.

Please note that there are many records that are already published, such as strategic plans, expense reports and other key Runnymede documents. You will receive a response within 30 days.

Personal health information that is in the custody or control of Runnymede is not subject to FIPPA. It is subject to the Personal Health Information Privacy Act (PHIPA).
